We have a strong and active committee led by Tim, the epitome of secretaries, a team of world class qualified judges and the all important volunteers forming a recipe that guarantees success.

I thank you all for supporting our club and look forward to a bright future.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Athletics in Victoria is alive and well. Like Athletics Victoria and the Victorian Little Athletics Association, our club has never been healthier. The trend of increasing club membership continued again this year as we hit an all time high of 187. Much of this increase is due to the work of the many coaches, both suburban and country, who bring new blood into our sport and who then point their aspiring walkers to our club. The following figures shows the upward membership trend over the last 8 years:

This year, our membership was split between 172 competitive members and 15 non-competitive members who were in various categories – general supporters, officials and life members. A breakdown shows almost equal numbers of male and female walkers although we have more girls than boys in the younger age groups. This is balanced by a predominance of men over women in the masters age groups.

A number of these members are country based walkers who join us as a 'second claim' walking club and compete with us when they can. Luckily for us, not everyone races every week but, none the less, this year witnessed record weekly racing numbers, averaging around 70 and surged towards 100 on major championship days.

With the continuing strong income from large membership subscriptions and racing fees, the club was able to feed back significant amounts of money into its facilities and members. Amongst the many benefits delivered were

- \$250 grants to each of the three Junior club members (Jess Rothwell, Regan Lambale and Rhydian Cowley) who competed at the 2008 IAAF World Racewalking Cup
- \$776 distributed to members via the Club Teams Fund
- \$440 distributed to members via the Merrifield Award
- \$2838 in trophies and prizes (3 prize days were held during the winter season. On each day, the designated winners were able to choose from prize pools in the vicinity of \$200, sourced from donations and club funds.)

Apart from these big ticket items, other smaller matters were dealt with as required. Bob Gardiner remains the prime worker behind most of these small ticket initiatives and his expertise and generous donation of time and tools is much appreciated by us all.

Once again, our winter season was delayed due to the March scheduling of the Australian Motor Racing Grand Prix. This year we could not schedule our first races at Albert Park until Sunday 19 April and in 2009 we do not expect to start racing at our Albert Park headquarters until early May. We have learnt to live with this intrusion into our yearly calendar and consequently the winter season remains shorter than it used to be. This does have an impact on our finances.

I would like to acknowledge the Middle Park Bowling Club who are very supportive landlords. Their facilities are top notch and give us a headquarters which is the envy of other clubs. I would also like to acknowledge Parks Victoria who allow us to use the service roads around Middle Park for our races. Like the Bowling Club, the Albert Park rangers are uniformly supportive and value us as park users.

We were lucky enough to be awarded an equipment grant this year from Parks Victoria and were able to invest in a new laser printer, 6 new equipment tables and a new equipment trolley. The total value of the grant was \$2770.

As usual, VRWC hosted a large number of championships at Albert Park. These included

- The 2007 Australian 50 km championships (Dec 2007)
- Three of the four days of the 2008 Athletics Victoria roadwalking championships (June-August 2008)
- The 2008 Athletics Victoria Schools roadwalking championships (June 2008)
- The 2008 Victorian Masters Association roadwalking championships (June and August 2008)
- Our own VRWC club championships (four sets in all)
- The 2008 Australian Roadwalking Championships and Second Federation Carnival (August 2008)

We also ran the 2008 Victorian Masters 5000m track championships for VMA in March 2008 and helped Athletics Australia run the Australian 20 km roadwalking championships at Fawkner Park in March 2008, providing equipment and manpower on both occasions.

This ongoing club support ensures that Victoria is the State of choice for major championships and gives our Victorian athletes ongoing access to major events.

We donated all takings from the RWA Interstate Challenge race day (12 July 2008) to Brain Tumour Research. What with race fees and donations and a top-up from the club, \$750 was forwarded to the Royal Melbourne Hospital Neuroscience Foundation. This fund raising initiative has now become a regular fixture item.

VRWC participated in all three Racewalking Australia Carnivals this year. In June, over 70 walkers travelled to Canberra for the biggest ever Lake Burley Griffin Carnival, with many of the walkers participating in a second event to help the club in the teams competitions. Overall, we were the dominant club, taking a strong lead in the Brennen Shield and winning 5 individual golds and 6 team golds. We then backed up in July for the RWA Interstate Challenge and were once again the top point scoring club. Finally in August at the Second Federation event in Melbourne, we made the most of our home ground advantage, winning the Brennen Shield for the second year in a row and winning 7 of the 13 Teams events on offer. This reinforces our current status as the strongest walking club in Australia.

This Second Federation carnival was combined with the 2008 Australian Roadwalking Championships as a pilot and it proved a great success. Instead of two small events, each with less than 100 competitors, we had 230 entries and just over 200 walkers in attendance on the day. VRWC was the main organiser and it was no mean feat to put such a large carnival into place and execute it on the day. I am pleased to report that all went well.

Our Masters walkers led by example - we are privileged to have more than our fair share of champions in the club. A number of new World and Australian Masters Records were set during the year by Margaret, Andrew and Ralph.

We are also privileged to have as club members many of Australia's current top walkers, including open walkers Nathan Deakes, Jared Tallent, Chris Erickson, Tom Barnes, Duane Cousins, Kellie Wapshott and Megan Szirom and junior walkers Jess Rothwell, Regan Lamble and Rhydian Cowley.

Nine of the 17 walkers selected for the 1008 IAAF Racewalking World Cup were Victorians – Nathan, Jared, Duane, Chris, Kellie, Megan, Jess, Regan and Rhydian. Jess also competed in the World Junior Championships while Jared, Chris and Kellie competed in the Olympics. Nathan had also been selected in the Olympic team but was a late scratching. The valiant efforts of our top walkers is discussed later in the report.

These elite club members are backed up by a large pool of talented youngsters who will hopefully provide the next generation of champions. Our challenge is to provide a nurturing environment in which they can continue to develop and hone their walking skills until they are ready to take over the mantle.

And, of course, there are the many club members who race for the love of the sport and to maintain their health and well being in a constructive and enjoyable way. All are vitally important to the club.

Speaking of this last group of walkers, we experimented this winter with an additional way of judging – 'Club Rules'. This proved successful and is to be continued this summer. Our 2008/2009 Summer Fixture has the following

All VRWC championship races are conducted in accordance with International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) Rules 230 and 240. Walkers competing in club non-championship races may choose to be judged in one of two ways – under full IAAF rules or under Club Rules. Club rules judge walkers on the very simple concept that the walker is walking to be best of his/her ability in a manner that does not give him/her an unfair advantage over other walkers.

Communication continues to be one of our strongest assets. This year, the Heel & Toe newsletter was published a record 52 times in 52 weeks! With Ray Smith and Stuart Cooper providing photographs and with a number of other people providing ongoing input, the newsletter was circulated to an ever growing distribution list of around 300 email addresses. Stuart Cooper also fed our results to the Press each week and it was great to see the Monday morning stats in the newspapers. Our website continues to grow and hosts more and more information each year.

It takes many people working together to run a successful club like ours. It is always difficult to single out particular people but I would like to mention

- Harry, Bob, Mark and Ron who shoulder much of the burden of race day coordination with me
- Barb, Joyce and Kate who provide for us all in the canteen and kitchen
- Paul, Lou, Ian, Stuart, Harry, Bob, Mark, Simon, Don, Susan, Ross, Michael and the many helpers and parents who look after the timekeeping and recording and equipment setup and pulldown
- Mark who does the handicapping and runs the coaching sessions
- Ray who mans the camera, shows the results after the race and forwards me photos for the newsletter
- Gordon, Peter, Lloyd, Fran, Elke, Brian, Kathleen and Michael who form the backbone of our judging panel with many of them on deck nearly every week

My apologies to anyone I have missed. There are so many people who make our club tick.

Finally, thank you to our VRWC committee who are all quiet achievers. We meet monthly to review and plan and guide the club forward. All the initiatives you take for granted are the results of committee review and deliberation and planning. Talking of our committee, we welcomed Ralph Bennett this year as our new Treasurer and he has done a fantastic job. We also created a new committee position, namely the Junior Club Captain. Natalie Laurie led by example in that role and is to be thanked for her leadership contribution to the club.

Thank you one and all for making this year such a successful one. I look forward to returning next year and helping us become an even bigger and better club.

42nd AFRWC WALKING CHAMPS, WESTON PARK, CANBERRA, 8 JUNE 2008

The 42nd Canberra Carnival was the biggest ever with 335 entries overall. Weather conditions were mild and sunny for the second year in a row and walkers made the most of the occasion with lots of big performances. The presence of 4 of our 2008 Olympic walkers (Jared Tallent, Adam Rutter, Chris Erickson and Claire Woods) gave the event a high profile and these walkers all performed brilliantly, as expected. TREASURER'S REPORT
FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1st October 2007 – 30th September 2008

As the new treasurer, and on behalf of the VRWC members, I would like to express my appreciation for the sound practices that are evident in the maintenance of the Club's financial accounts over recent years. This is due, primarily, to the steady hand of Michael Bodey over some eight years and, for the first six months of this year, to the efforts of the ever reliable Bob Gardiner.

Financially, this has been another solid year for the Club. Subscriptions have again shown a modest increase which has balanced a marginal decrease in race fees. I would like to acknowledge the valuable and reliable service provided by Ron Miller in recording race entries and collecting payments.

This year, as there were sufficient funds in our trading accounts to cover operating costs, and we have a predictable cash flow, the Committee decided to reinvest all interest earned on our three term deposits in order to take advantage of prevailing high term-deposit interest rates.

Although the surplus of receipts over expenditure in our operating accounts (\$1,825) is significantly less than last year (\$5,230), this reflects our decision to reinvest the interest from our term deposits rather than bring it into our operating accounts. In fact, the Club has improved its financial position this year by \$9,075.

A significant factor in this very favourable result is the timely effort of our secretary, Tim Erickson, to ensure submissions for potential grants and reimbursements are initiated and vigorously followed through.

The unstinting efforts of our canteen ladies, Joyce, Barbara and Kate, have helped us to provide: a very valued service to our race day participants; to return a good profit on canteen and catering operations (\$640, plus \$800 yet to be transferred from the General Account to cover expenditure on RWA Carnival catering); and, to enhance our reputation as a welcoming and supportive club.
