It was further resolved to alter the Jubilee Shield to become a 2 Mile race for Boys under the age of 17 years on the day of competition.

## Lorna Carrington Cup – 2 Miles Walk for Women

In one of the fastest girls' races seen in this State for a couple of years, NSW again retained the Lorna Carrington Cup, with an easy win over Victoria and South Australia, at Albert Park, last Saturday. Final points

Bernie Jeacle (NSW) lead the field from "go to woe" and went through the mile in 8:34, followed by Helen O'Connor (NSW), Shirley Cooper (8.39) and June O'Connor (8.40), with the nearest Victorian girl being Judy Fisher in sixth plce in 8.57, and that was the way they finished. Bernie increased her lead and crossed the line in first place in 17.28, with Helen (NSW) 8 seconds away in 17.36 and June passing Shirley (both NSW) to finish in third place 3 seconds in front of Shirley in 17.37 to 17.40. Then after a gap of nearly a minute came Rhonda Whitehorn (NSW) in 18.39, with South Australian girl Elaine McFarlane 6<sup>th</sup> in 19.04, with C Hill of NSW 7<sup>th</sup> in 19.13, with Betty Newman being the first Victorian girl to cross the line and she finished in 8<sup>th</sup> place in 19.21. Betty was followed by two more Victorian girls in Elizabeth Grierson who improved her personal best by 41 seconds with a very smart 20.36, and Marion Parkinson who walked up to her most recent form with a pretty stylish 20.37.
