The Alexander Cup was run in conjunction with the Australian 20km Championship and was held in Centennial Park in Sydney. Mexican Olympian Frank Clark successfully defended his road title in cool windy conditions. Frank was on his own out the front and clocked a good 91:56, one of his best efforts over the distance. This should ensure him a place for the Commonwealth Team for Los Angeles later this year.

Noel Freeman overcame a leg injury and finished about 150m behind in 92:57 for the silver medal. Bob Gardiner moved into third place when Graeme Nicholls was disqualified, and held it with 98:07. NSW junior Stephen Hausfeld showed good form for 99:37 and was the only other to beat 100 minutes. NSW was able to win the teams event on a countback from the favoured Victorians.
