- 39 year old **Kelly Ruddick** was amongst my Top 10 Women last year and she reinforced that last Saturday in AV Shield competition, recording a 24 sec PB time of **13:02.10** in winning at Geelong. This is also a VRWC W35 club record and pushes her into the top 20 of my Australian All-Time list.
- 16 year old Kyle Bird has only been racewalking for 18 months but in that short timeframe, he has shown himself a very capable athlete. Competing in the AV Shield Competition at Ballam Park on Saturday, his winning time of 13:27.4 was a 29 sec PB.

MUNSTER AAI INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS, NENAGH, SUNDAY 6 JANUARY 2013

Robert Heffernan (Togher AC), fourth in the 50k walk at the Olympics, was back in action recently at the Munster Indoor championships in the Nenagh Olympic stadium. On this occasion he competed in the 5,000m and recorded a comfortable win in a time of 19:13.82, some thirty seconds faster than he has done in any previous season's opener. Heffernan's training partner Brendan Boyce (Letterkenny AC), who also competed in the Olympic 50k walk and is now based in Cork where he is coached by Heffernan, chased him home in a time of 19:39.11 to take over twenty seconds off his indoor best. Cian McMenaman (Westport AC), who has also changed his base to Cork to train with Heffernan, was third in 20:18.96 taking over twenty seconds off his indoor best. Another of Heffernan's squad, Luke Hickey (Leevale AC) won the junior 5,000m race, held in conjunction with the seniors, in 21:28.56, 47 seconds faster than his previous best.

Her time of 12:38.2 in the Youth 3000m was outstanding. Natalia Makarova (21:53.0) and Iuriy Andronov (19:44.8) were the winners in the 5000m walks. The meet saw a total of 92 walkers in the various events. Unfortunately we only have the results from the 5000m walk.

1957 - Dominican Republic: 1956 Olympic Champions

We have seen this set of 8 stamps before but this partial copy of the stamp set is of special significance as it is signed by Norman Read, the 1956 Olympic 50km champion featured on the walks stamp. Owner Alex Wijsman explains:

This cover was signed by Norman Read when he was in Europe. Harold ven Beek arranged it for me. Norman was surprised and liked it very much. He said: "This is the first time that I have signed such a thing." A few months later he died.





1954 - San Marino

Again, we have seen this stamp before - it was one of the two very first stamps to feature the sport of racewalking, being issued by San Marino in 1954.

Alex has shown me two more Postal Cards featuring this stamp. Each picture on the Photo Cards again features Giuseppe Dordoni. The photo with start number 154 is the original and the second is a negative photo. Interesting stuff!






1957 - Dominican Republic

Again, although we have reviewed this stamp before, Alex has provided further information about it so it gets a second look.

The Ugo Frigerio stamp was issued twice more, each time with a different overprint.

The first re-issue featured the words 'Asistencia Refugiados Hungaros 1957' - Help to the people from Hungary 1957. Leaflets were also issued in the Dominican Republic at the same time.

The second re-issue was in 1959 and featured the words 'III Juegos Deportivos Panamericanos' - III Pan American Games.



1956 - Australia

And finally an Australian postcard which was released during the 1956 Olympics in Melbourne. The 1956 Olympic postmark, although faint, definitely shows a racewalker. It is dated 22 Nov 1956 - the 50km walk was on Nov 24 and the 20km walk was on Nov 28 so it must have been released at the start of the athletics program. I wonder if other sporting related postmarks were also released during these Games?


