It was her inaugural attempt at such a long distance and was an impressive first up. Rebecca won the U14 3000m championship at the Australian Junior T&F Championships in March (15:10) and won the U12 2km walk at last year's Canberra Carnival (10:03). She will be competing in the U14 and U16 events at this year's Canberra Carnival in 3 weeks time and will certainly be in the mix once again. Congrats Rebecca!

ITALIAN CLUBS RACE WALKING CHAMPIONSHIPS, MISTERBIANCO, ITALY, SUNDAY 18 MAY

Marcialtaliana reports (see http://www.marciaitaliana.com/ita/dettagli_news.aspx?id=1777) that **Anna Eleonora Giorgi**, competing in the latest leg of the Italian Clubs Race Walking Championships in Misterbianco (Catania), has set a new Italian track record of **20:01.80** for the **5000m track walk**. The time also breaks Irish walker Gillian O'Sullivan's world best time which was set on 13th July 2002 in Dublin. It also breaks the current Italian record which belonged to Elisabetta Perrone (20:12:41, Rieti, 2nd August 2003). While still shy of the road best of 19:46, held by Kjersti Tysse Plaetzer, set at Hildesheim (GER) on 27th August 2006, it is a superb track walk and the third record set by this super talented young walker this year.
