WALKER OF THE WEEK

Only a short newsletter this week, given the busy nature of Christmas and the small number of races curretly being held. Before going on the racewalking news of the week, a quick wish to all our readers that you have a safe Christmas break, surrounded by friends and family. And now off we go.....

My Walker of the Week is once again 17 year old Perth walker **Declan Tingay**. Walking in the Athletics Victoria Shield competition last Saturday in Geelong, he powered through the 3000m walk in a 10 sec PB time of **11:40.32**, bettering Troy Sundstrom's Australian U18 3000m Australian record of 11.42.04, set in Sydney in 1998.

The previous weekend at Fawkner Park, he bettered Troy Sundstrom's Australian U18 10km record of 42:47 with his time of 42:36. The previous weekend, he won the U18 5000m walk at the Australian Schools Championships in a PB time of 20:11.80. Talk about a walker in rare form!

- The IAAF may reanalyze Russian samples from the 2014 world indoor track championships over suspicions that athletes who failed doping tests were allowed to compete. Messages between then-Moscow laboratory director Grigory Rodchenkov and Sports Ministry official Alexei Velikodny, released on Friday 9th December as part of WADA investigator Richard McLaren's report into Russian doping, show eight athletes gave suspicious samples the week before they were to travel to the competition in Sopot, Poland.
