WALKER OF THE WEEK

My walker of the week this time around is **Ela Uzun**. Competing in the annual Victorian Little Athletics Championships at Lakeside Stadium in Melbourne on Saturday morning, she stormed through the U10 Girls 1100m in a time of **5:20.09**. This bettered Nicole Sansonetti's Victorian record of 5:30.00, set way back in 1984, and also bettered NSW walker Kini Chapple's U10 1100m Australian Best performance of 5.21.2, set in 2004.

And that was not all for Ela last weekend. On Sunday, when competing in a VRWC 1500m walk at Clifton Hill, she recorded a time of **7:18.0**, setting new VRWC U10 and U11 club records. Even more amazingly, her time of 7:18.0 was faster than the winning times in the U13-U16 1500m Girls walks from the LAVIC Championships the day before.

LAVIC T&F CHAMPIONSHIPS, LAKESIDE STADIUM, ALBERT PARK, 13014 MARCH 2021

The Little Athletics Victoria T&F Championships are the culmination of a long process that takes place each summer. The best little athletes from each centre are decided via centre championships. They then progress to Region Championships where the numbers are culled even more. Then finally, the best of the Region athletes come together for the State final. And that still meant 212 walkers contesting the walks at Lakeside Stadium last Saturday morning. And it was a case of very lucky, as a wet cold change reached Melbourne on Saturday afternoon, making conditions dreadful. But the walks had been completed in perfect conditions earlier in the day – talk about lucky!

Full walk results are shown below. The bracketed number is the Little Athletics Centre. For instance, (1123) is Whittlesea.

The best performers were **Ela Uzun** (U10 1100m 5:20.09), **Damian Baldy** (U11 1100m 5:19.13), **Riley Coughlan** (U15 1500m 6:53.55) and **Liam Hutchins** (U15 1500m 6:58.58. The best centre performance was in the U10 Girls 1100m where Whittlesea came first, second and third (**Ela Uzun**, **Mya McClure** and **Havana Ali**).
