- 3. The next 3 walkers to finish for that club will be designated as their second team and so on.
- 4. All team members must be aged 12 years or older on the day. Scoring of Teams Points will be in line with the AV Cross Country scoring system.

MARCIADALMONDO & O MARCHADOR ROUNDUP

As one would expect, fast 35km times are appearing regularly as the World walking championships in Muscat approach. Brazil's **Caio Bonfim** left no doubts about where his sights are set with this impressive effort at the weekend.

New Brazilian 35km record set by Bonfim

(reprinted from O Marchador)

Bragança Paulista (BRA) 9 January - **Caio Bonfim**, athlete from CASO in Brasilia, was the main figure of the Brazilian Athletic Marching Championships that took place yesterday in Bragança Paulista (São Paulo), on a thousand-meter circuit, established in the vicinity of Bragança Garden Shopping, beating the national record for 35 km march, with a time of 2:33:57. After completing the first kilometer in 4:11, the splits in each 5 km were 21:29, 21:51, 21:48, 21:53, 22:04, 22:23 and 22:29 (4: 16 on the final lap).

The mark now established by Caio Bonfim, in a distance that is being cemented in the main national championships around the world and in major international competitions, replacing the 50 km, largely surpasses the previous record, which was already his own, when he passed through the 50 km of the Rio de Janeiro Olympic Games, in 2016 (2:39:19), being the second of all time in the South American ranking of the specialty. The day before, in Machala (Ecuador), Daniel Pintado had achieved a new South American record with 2:32:40.

Still in the men's 35 km, a reference for the other athletes who made it to the Brazilian podium, all filled with athletes from the Sobradinho Athletics Center, Diego Lima, with 2:53:09, and Max Batista dos Santos, with 2:59: 50.

In the women's 35 km there was, in a way, a surprise with the victory of **Elianay Pereira Barbosa**, also from CASO (DF), who completed the 35 laps of the circuit in a time of 3:10:08, leaving the favorite, Viviane Santana Lyra (Associação Fortes e Velozes-RJ), in the second position with the mark of 3:11:45. Mayara Luize Vicentainer (FME TIMBÓ) completed the podium with a time of 3:14:15. It should be noted that the Brazilian and South American record belongs to Erica Rocha de Sena, with 2:51:11 (Macas, ECU, 3-13-2021).

And to conclude ... US magazine 'Track & Field News' has released its top 10 rankings for 2021 in all events, including the 50km walk.

This article by Pedro Peixoto (o Marchador) contains the 50km listing and an explanatory note. Well done, Rhydian.

The merit rankings of the North American magazine Track and Field News (T&FN) were released, one of the few publications distinguished with the Heritage Award of the International Athletics Federation.

In the 50km march, João Vieira is considered the 5th best specialist in 2021, corresponding exactly to the place where he was in the Games.

These T&FN rankings – which have nothing to do with the lists of brands obtained or the World Athletics Rankings – are based on the principles established in 1948 by Don Potts and Roberto Quercetani: Honors achieved (read rankings in important events or records obtained), direct confrontations and sequence of brands.

In a specialty in which athletes do not multiply in competitions, quite the contrary, it is natural that the most important competition, in this case the Olympic Games, was the determining factor and naturally it was.

The first six classified in the Games occupy positions 1 to 6 of the ranking, followed by the winner of the very strong championships in Japan, where the best marks of the year were obtained; the 7th and 8th of Saporo were in the following positions, closing with the winner of the Chinese championship.
